



MOLE COMPETITION RULES

1. One entry per business. Entry fee of \$75 submitted with each form.
2. We provide one booth space with a table, table cloth and skirt, one pop-up tent , one chair and a sign.
3. A minimum of two people are required at your booth.
4. A color scheme will be assigned to your booth and you are encouraged to decorate.
5. Please have ingredient information available to provide information for people with food allergies.
6. We advise you prepare 7 gallons of mole. Tasting will continue thru 4 pm. Having a sample thru to 4:00 could influence the voting as more people will taste your sample.
7. Tasting booth will operate from 11 am – 4 pm on Saturday, Sept. 19, 2015.
8. The winner of the People Choice will be chosen based on the number of the most tickets received.
9. The winner of the Judge’s Choice will be based on a blind test by a panel of judges.
10. Awards are non-monetary items.
11. SET UP WILL BE ALLOWED FROM 4 PM FRIDAY, SEPT. 18 UNTIL 9 AM SATURDAY, SEPT. 19.
The festival provides an evening security guard to patrol the area overnight. Set-up outside of these time will put a burden on yourself as street access will be closed and items will have to be carried in from off-site parking.
